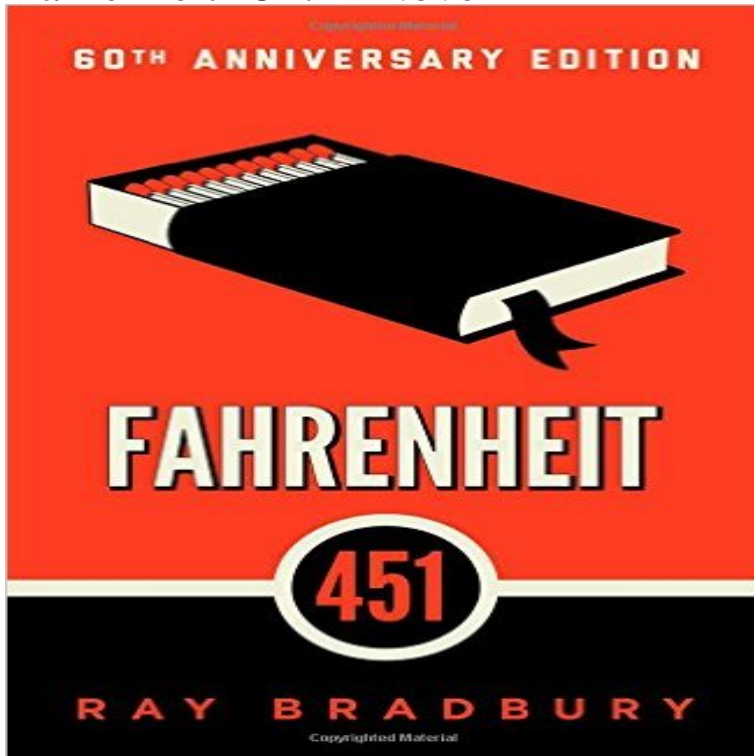


Fahrenheit 451: A Novel
