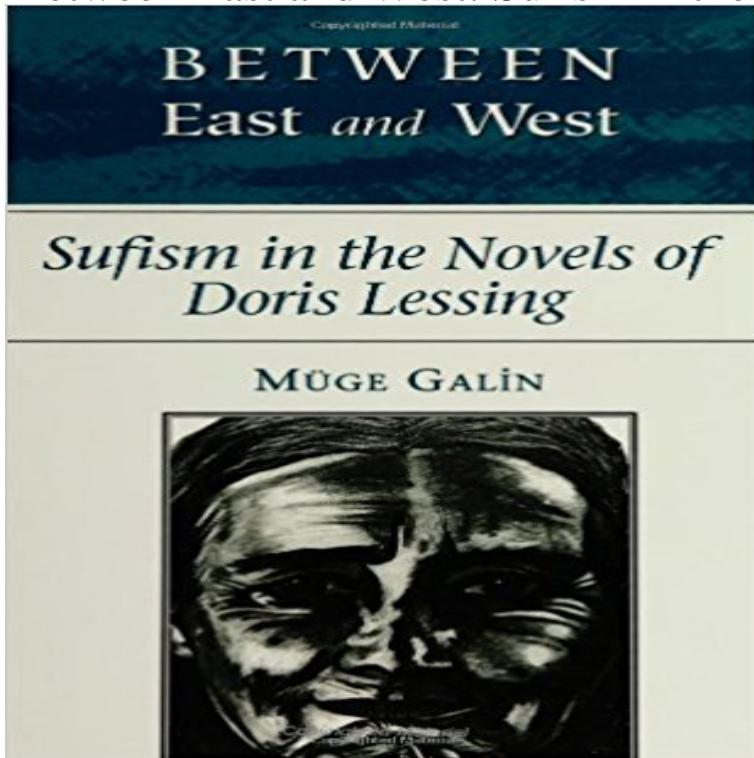


# Between East and West: Sufism in the Novels of Doris Lessing
