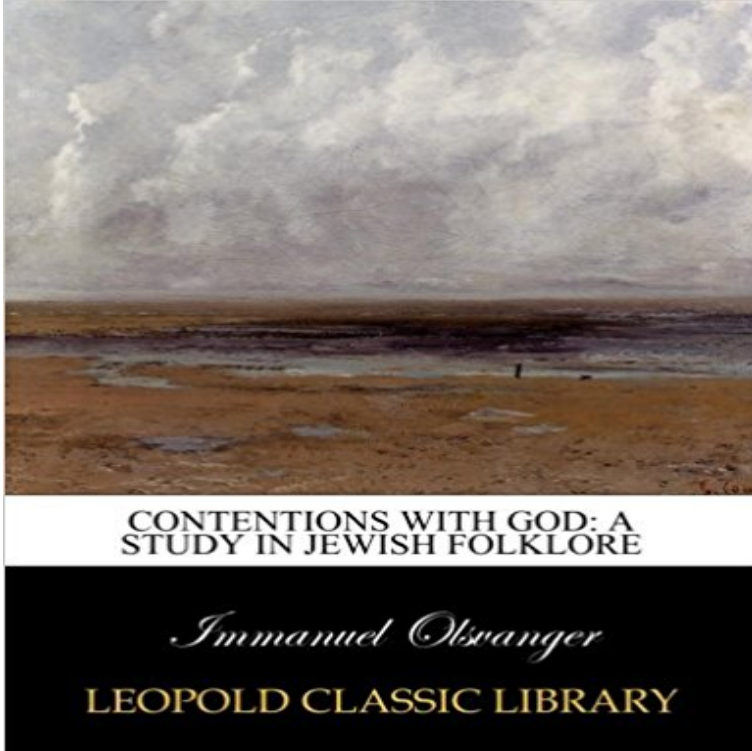


Contentions with God: a study in Jewish folklore
