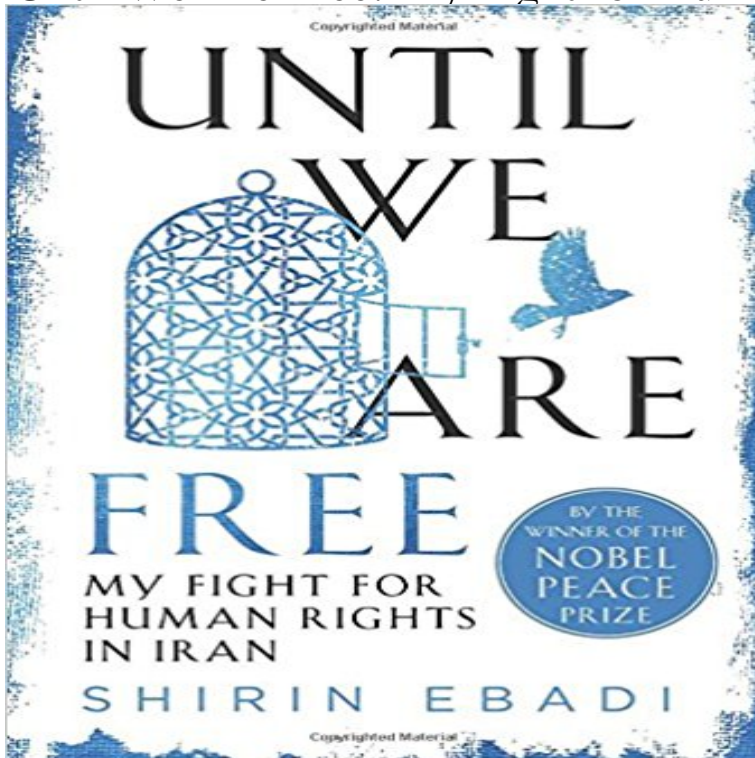


Until We Are Free: My Fight for Human Rights in Iran

It shut down her lectures, fired up mobs to attack her home, seized her offices, and nailed a death threat to her front door. But it was not until she received a phone call from her distraught husband—and he made a shocking confession that would all but destroy her family—that she realized what the intelligence apparatus was capable of to silence its critics. The Iranian government would end up taking everything from Shirin Ebadi—her marriage, friends, and colleagues, her home, her legal career, even her Nobel Prize—but the one thing it could never steal was her spirit to fight
