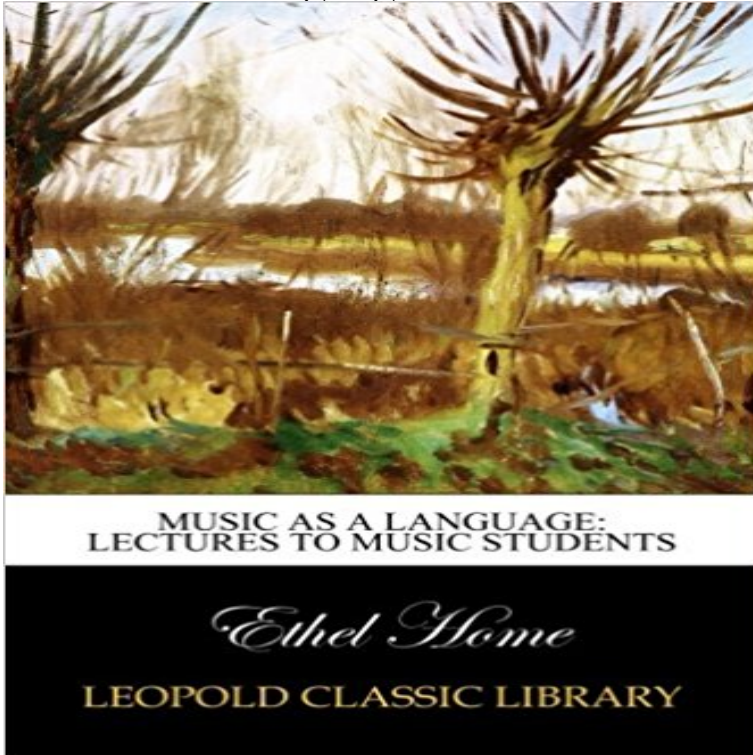


Music as a Language: Lectures to Music Students

will not detract from the experience.
