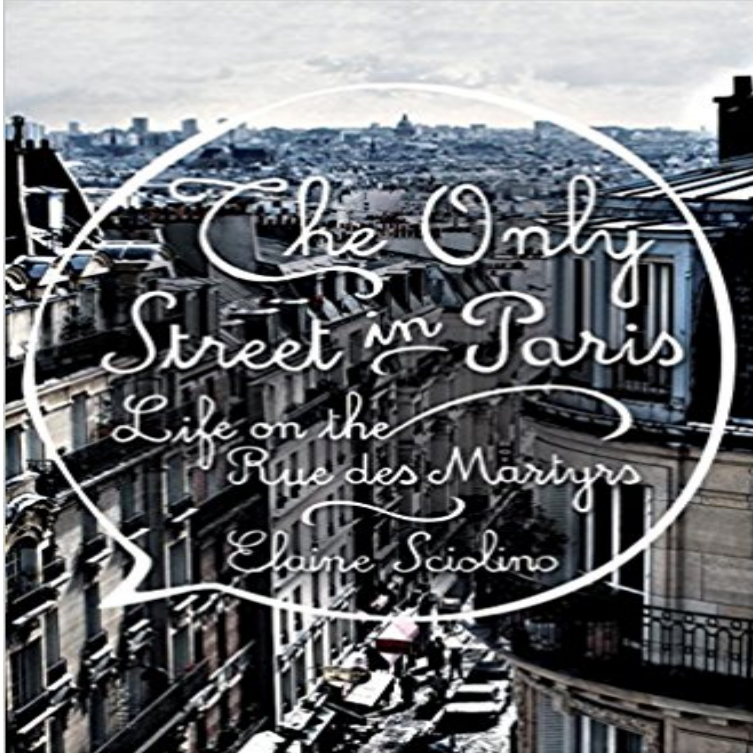


The Only Street in Paris: Life on the Rue des Martyrs
