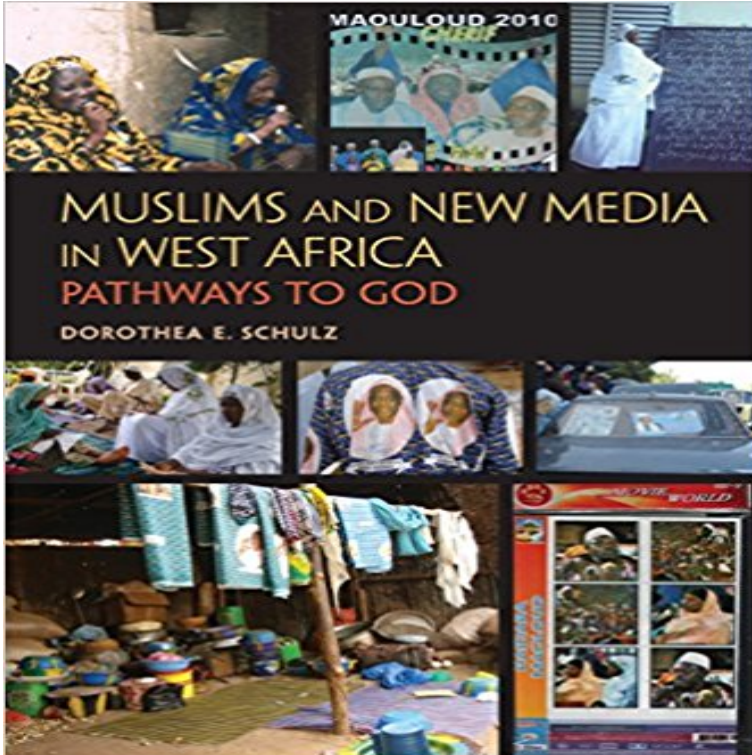


Muslims and New Media in West Africa: Pathways to God
