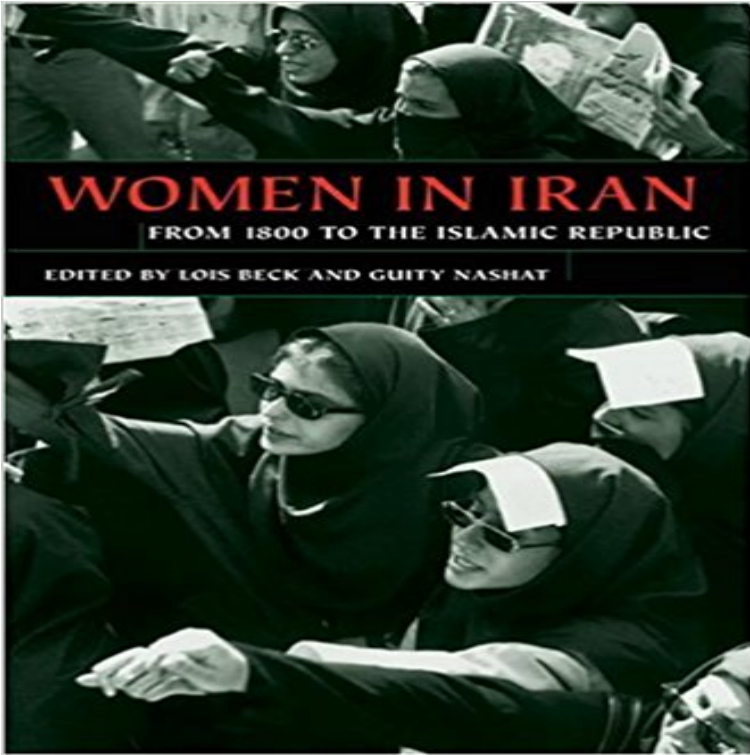


Women in Iran from 1800 to the Islamic Republic

Several contributors address the issue of regional, ethnic, linguistic, and tribal diversity in Iran, which has long contained complex, heterogeneous societies.
