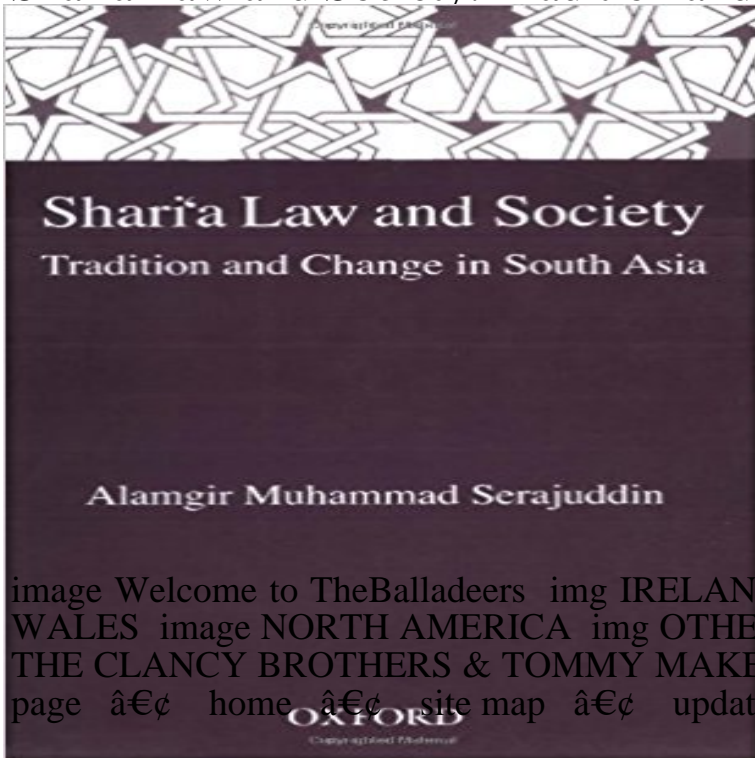


# Sharia Law and Society: Tradition and Change in South Asia
