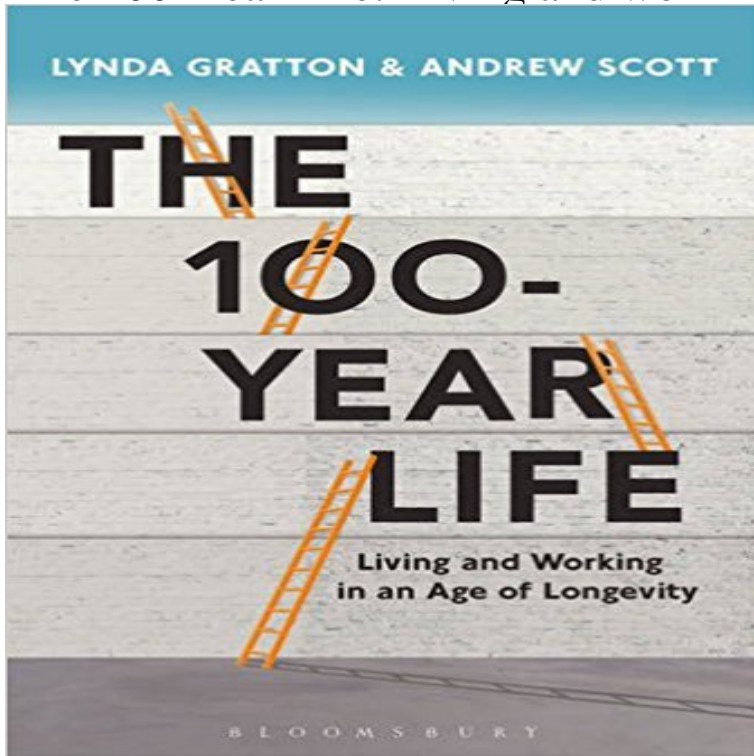


The 100-Year Life: Living and working in an age of longevity
