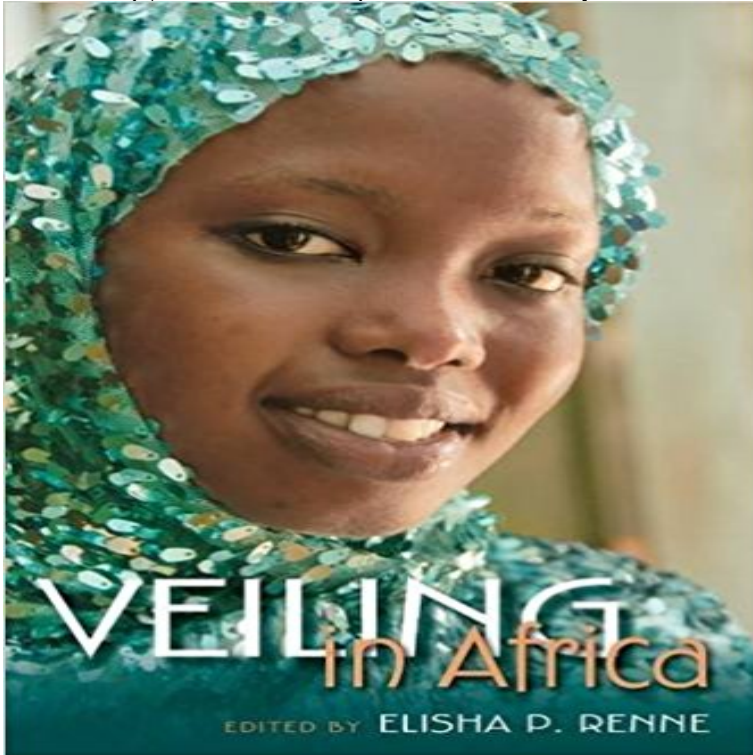


## Veiling in Africa (African Expressive Cultures)
