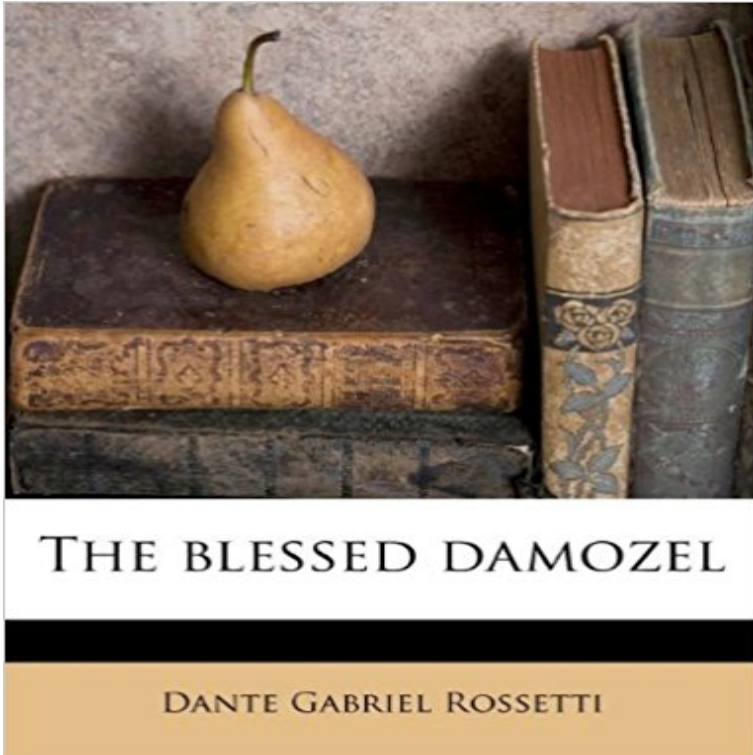


## The blessed damozel
