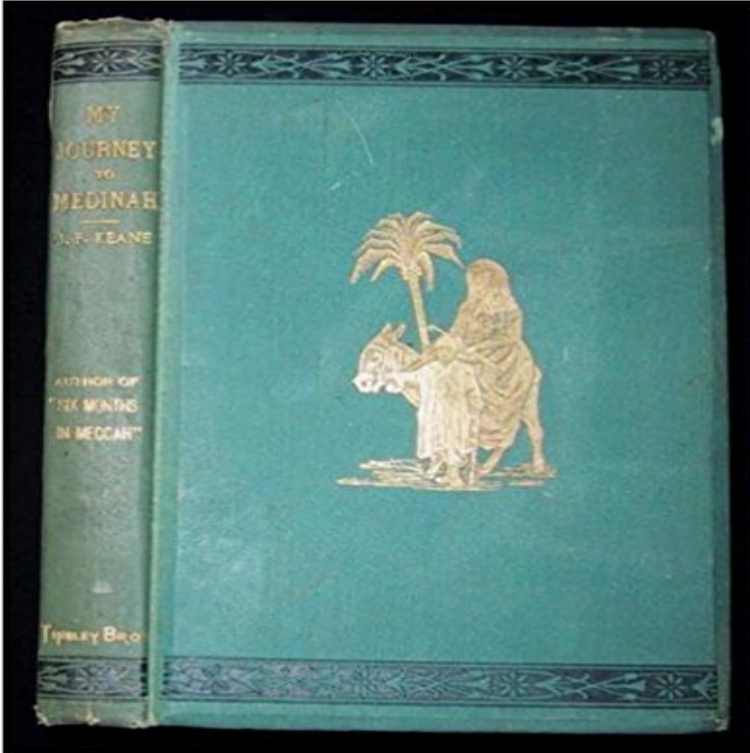


My journey to Medinah: Describing a pilgrimage to Medinah,
