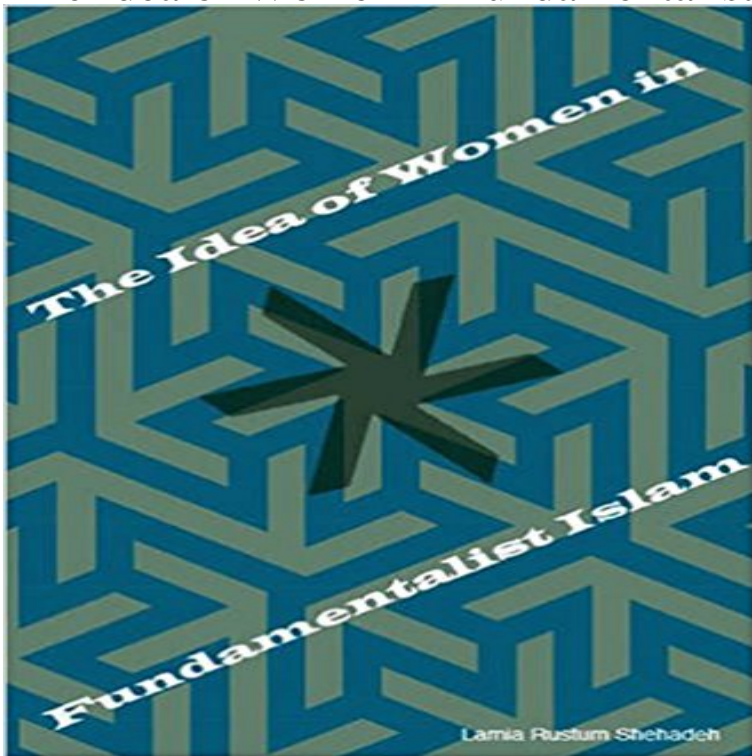


The Idea of Women in Fundamentalist Islam
