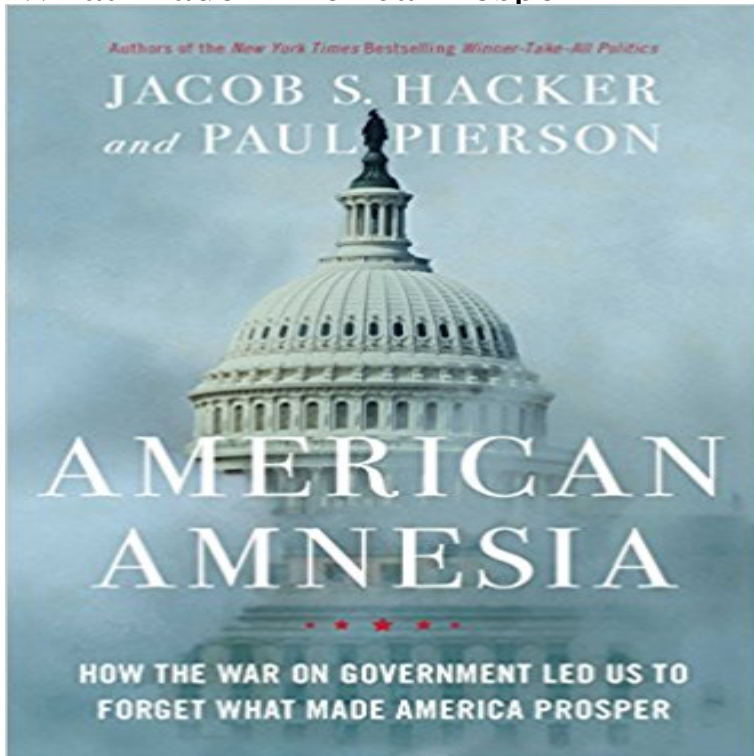


# American Amnesia: How the War on Government Led Us to Forget What Made America Prosper
