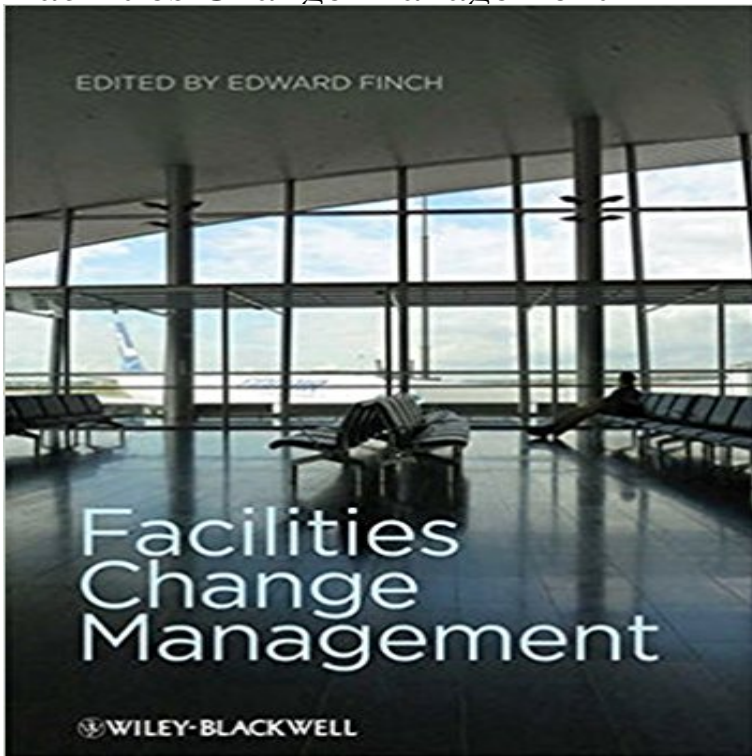


# Facilities Change Management



Modern organisations are subject to continual change - technologies evolve, organisational structures are modified, people and underlying cultures are transformed.
