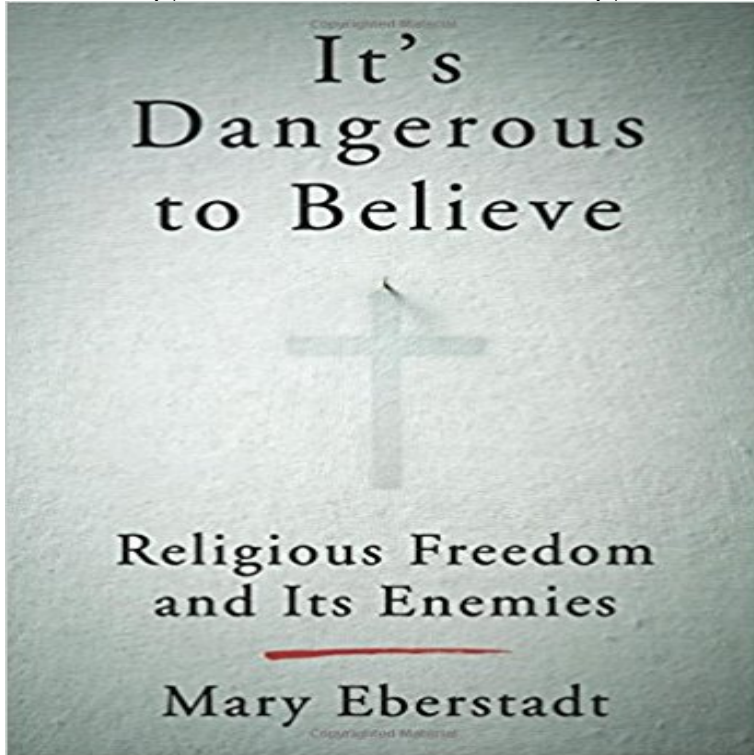


Its Dangerous to Believe: Religious Freedom and Its Enemies
