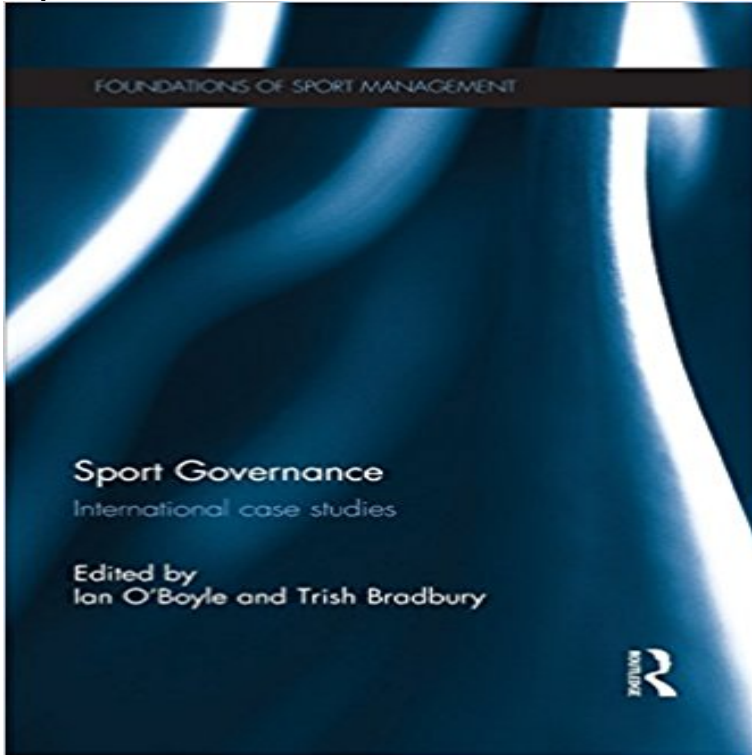


Sport Governance: International Case Studies



Governance has become a hugely important issue within sport.
