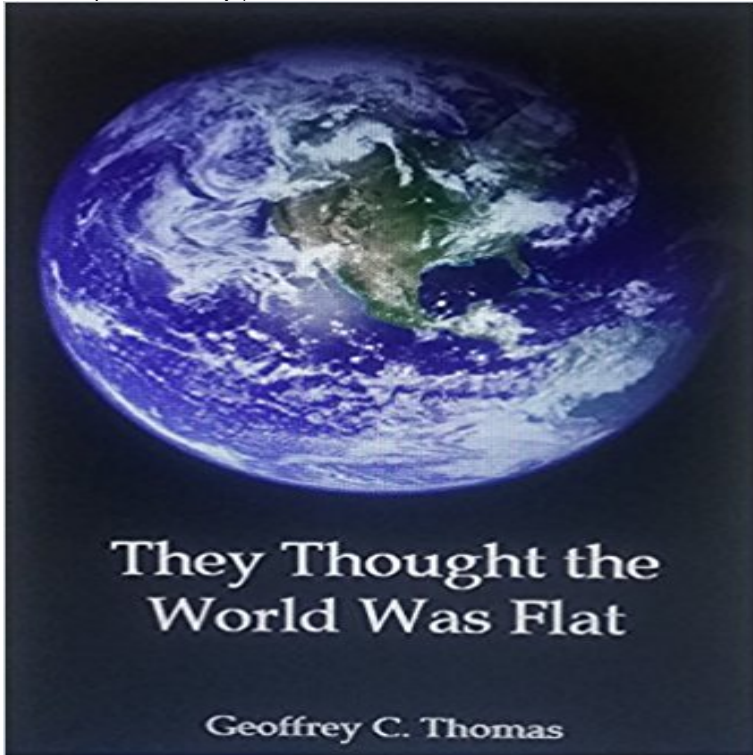


They Thought the World Was Flat
