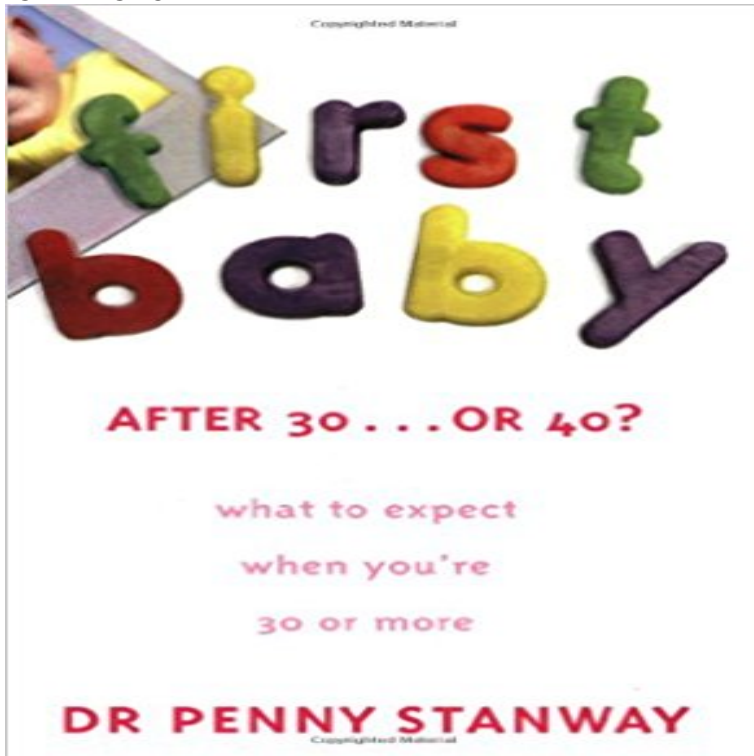


# First Baby After 30 ... or 40: What to Expect When You're 30-Something or More
