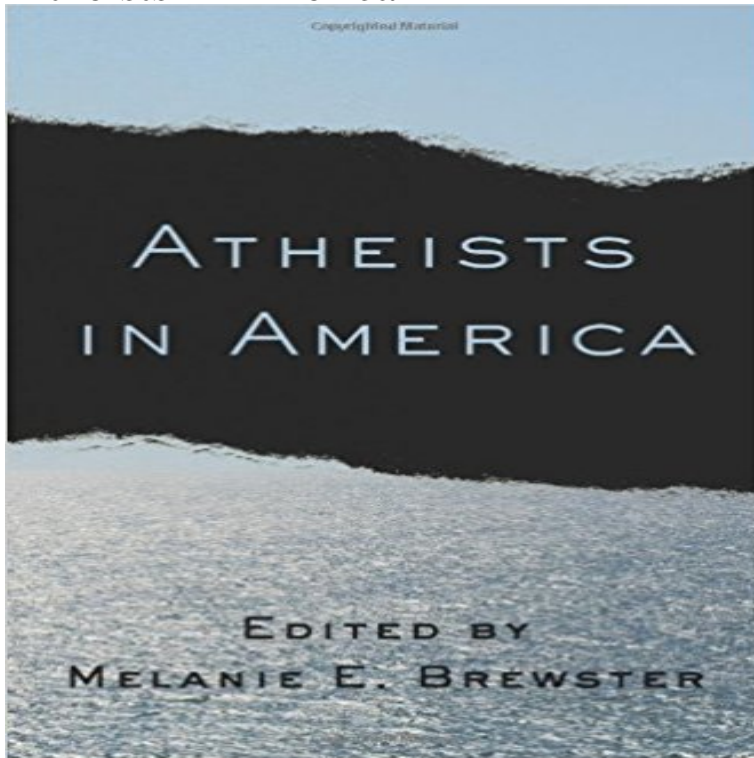


Atheists in America
