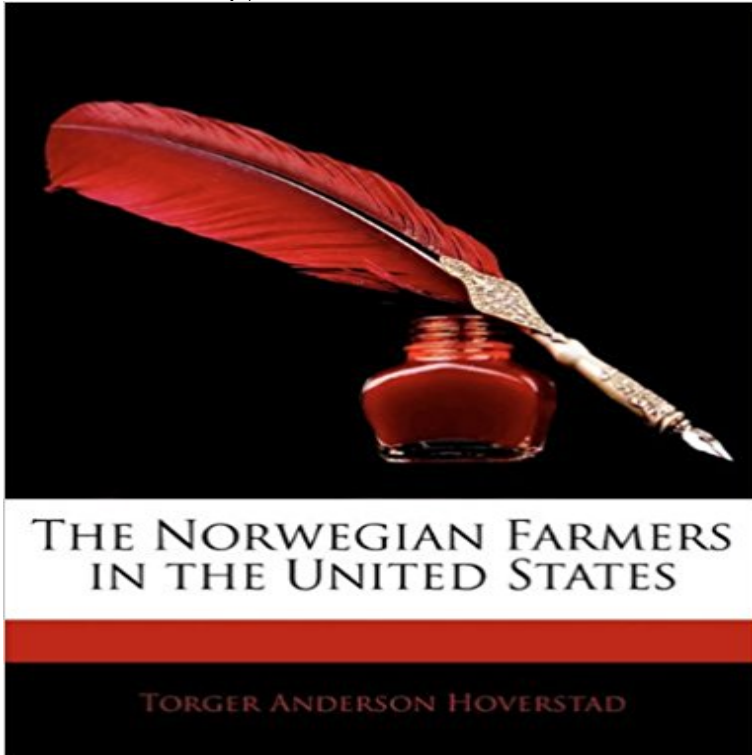


# The Norwegian Farmers in the United States
