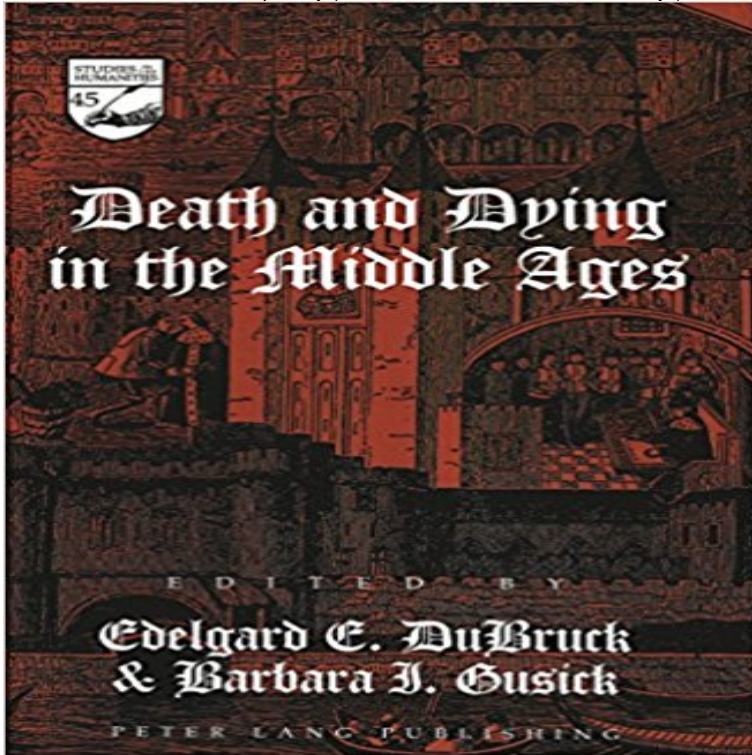


Death and Dying in the Middle Ages
