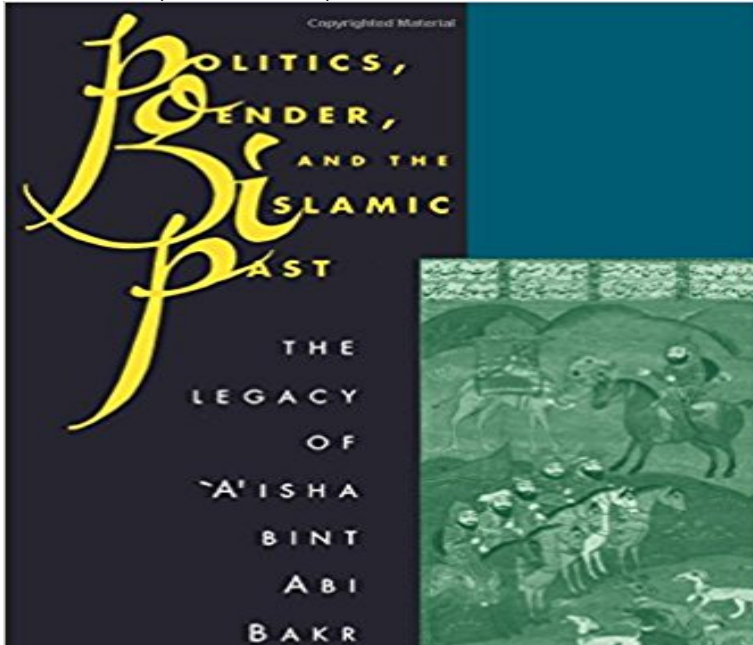


Politics, Gender, and the Islamic Past
