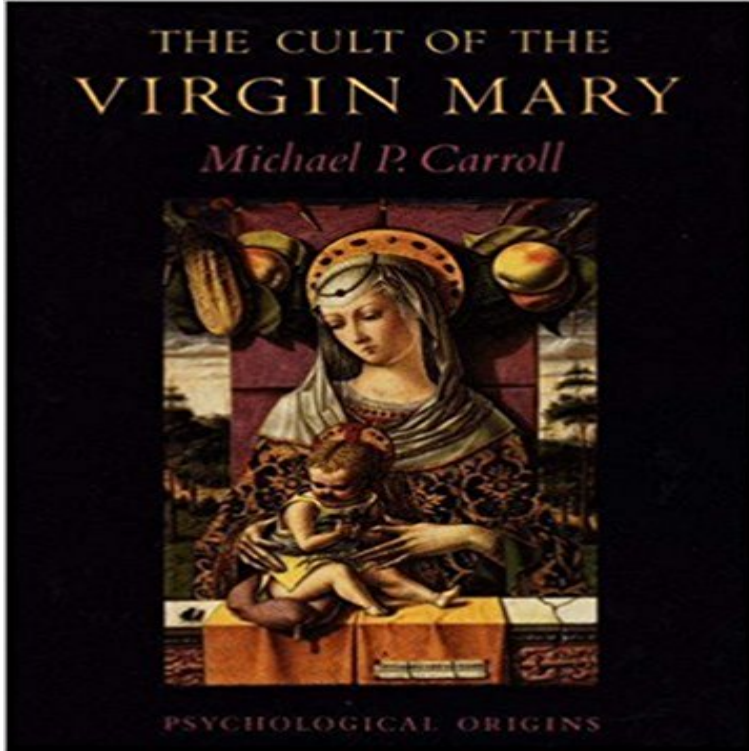


# The Cult of the Virgin Mary: Psychological Origins
