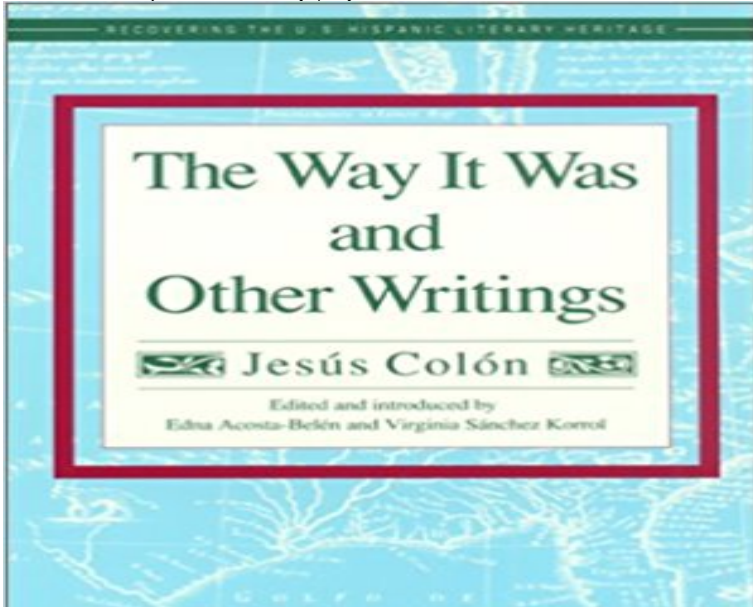


The Way It Was and Other Writings (Recovering the Us Hispanic Literary Heritage)
