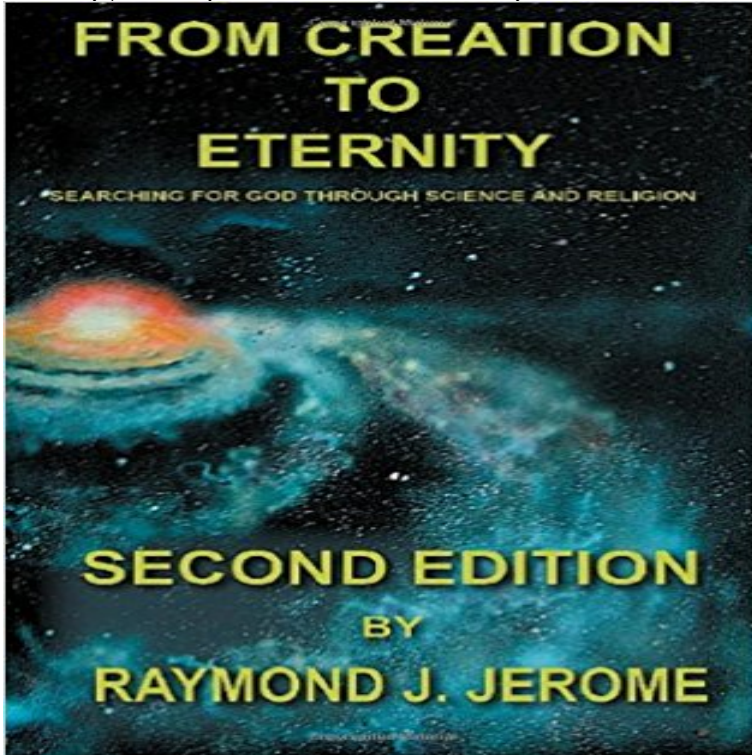


# From Creation to Eternity: Searching for God Through Science and Religion. (Second Edition)
