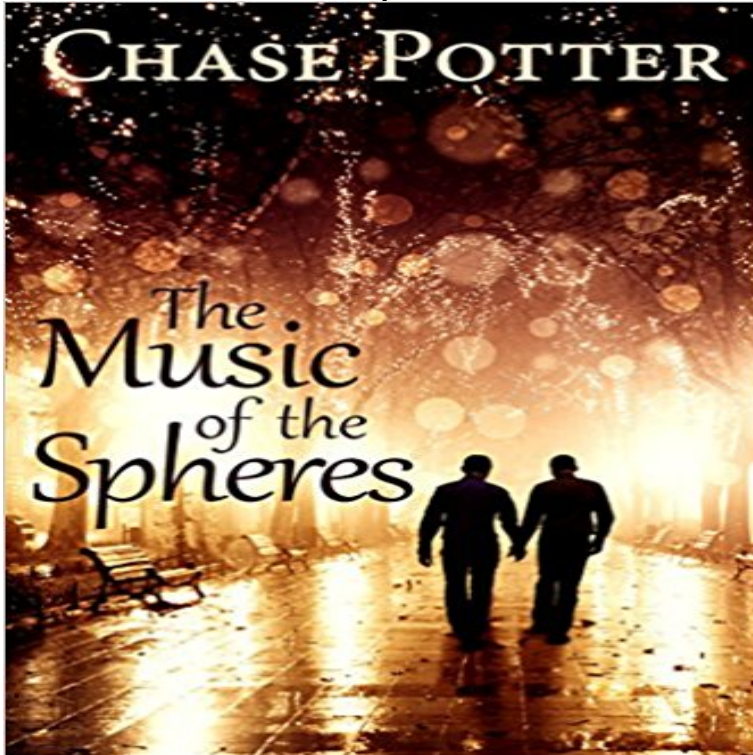


The Music of the Spheres
