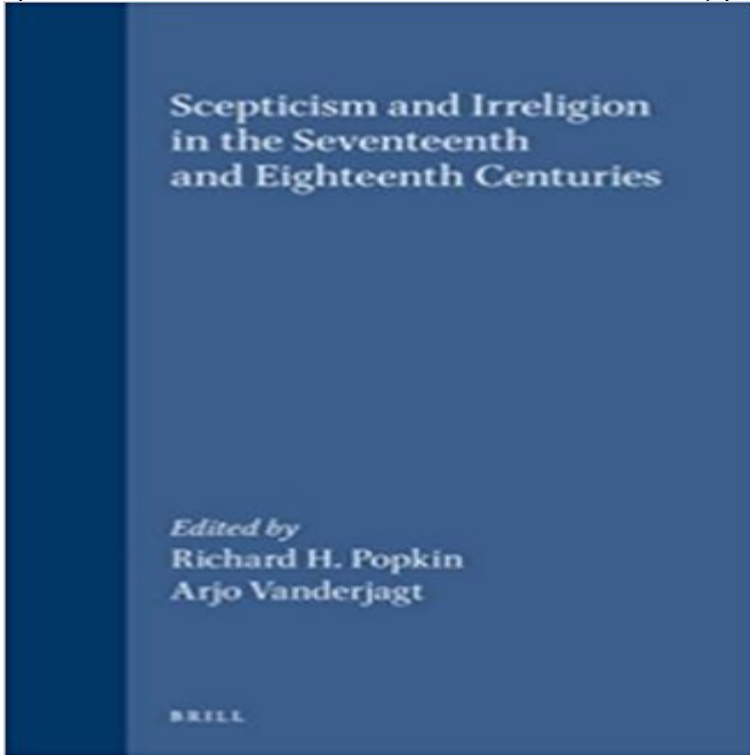


Skepticism and Irreligion in the Seventeenth and Eighteenth Centuries (Brills Studies in Intellectual History)
