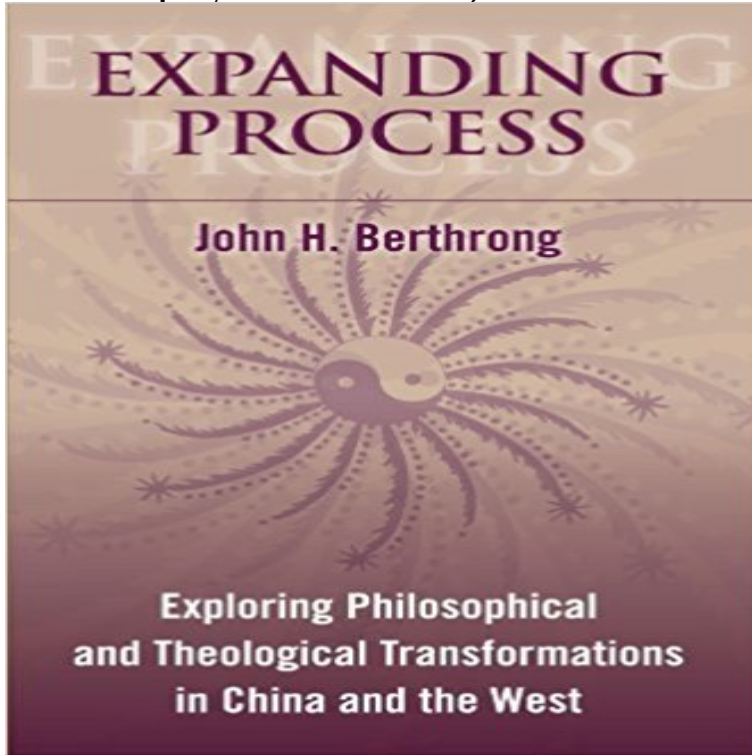


# Expanding Process: Exploring Philosophical and Theological Transformations in China and the West (SUNY series in Chinese Philosophy and Culture)
