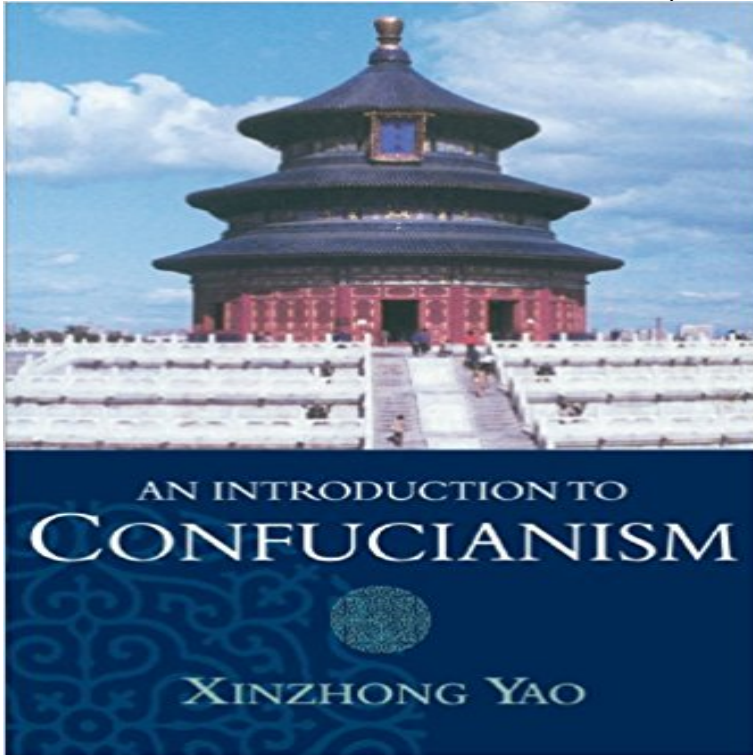


An Introduction to Confucianism (Introduction to Religion)
