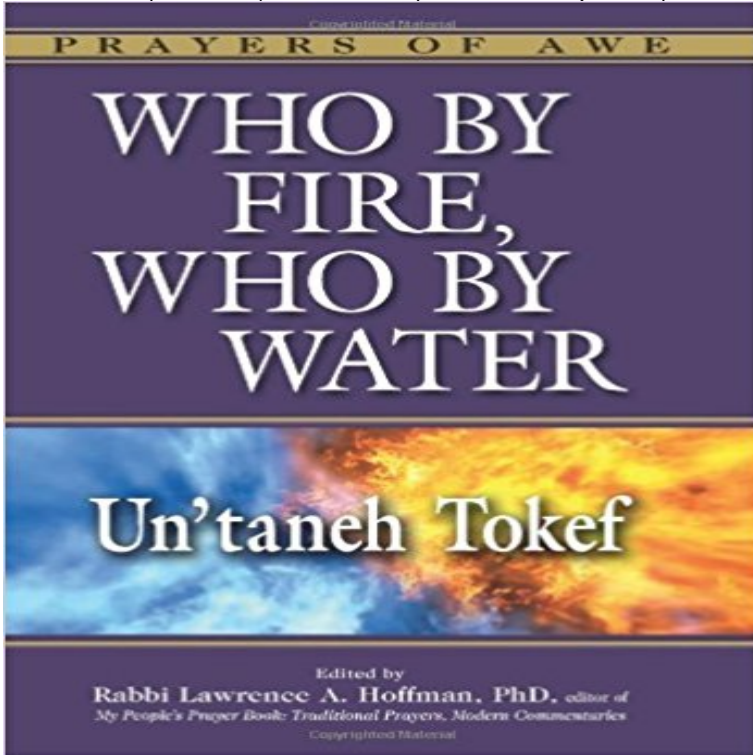


Who by Fire, Who by Water (Prayers of Awe)
