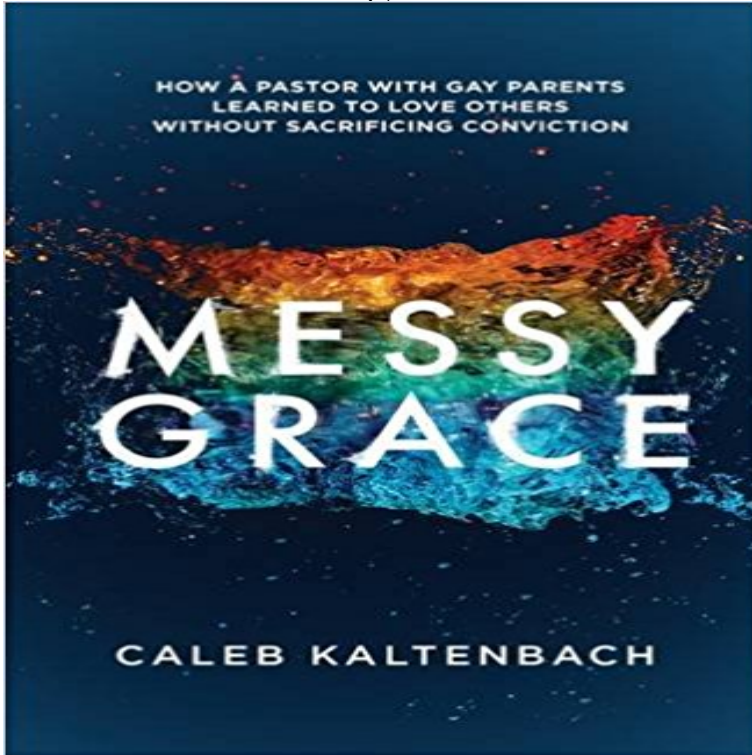


Messy Grace: How a Pastor with Gay Parents Learned to Love Others Without Sacrificing Conviction
