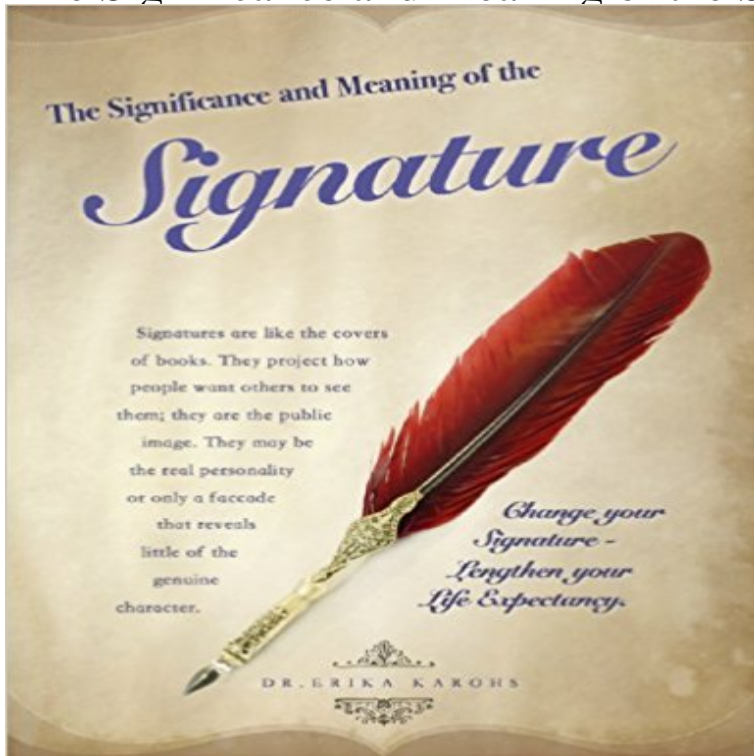


The Significance and Meaning of the Signature
