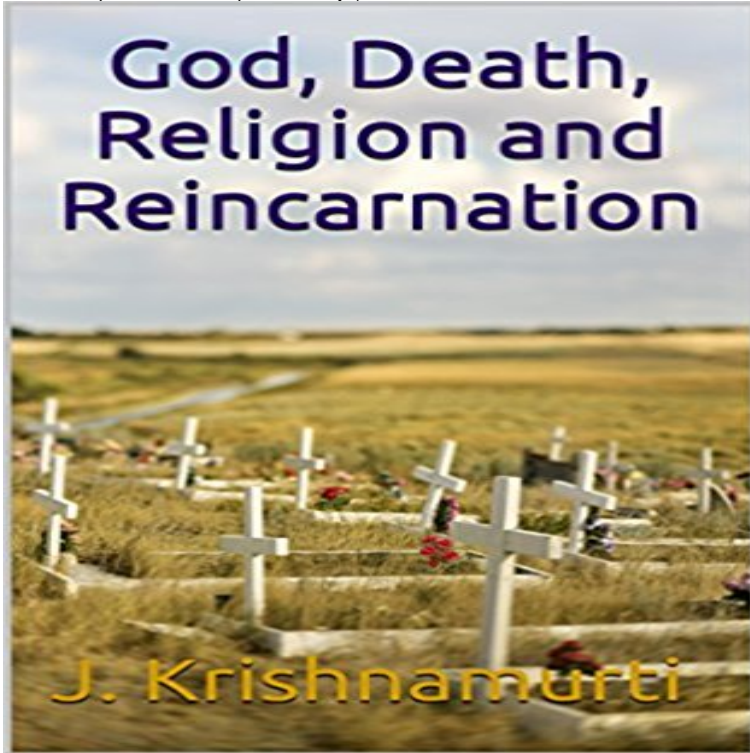


God, Death, Religion and Reincarnation

You begin, without the desire to understand or to fulfil, merely to inquire into the purpose of environment; and in discovering

that purpose..... Is God to be believed in? Read another excerpt from the book: The priests, the preachers, the organizers of religions, the bishops, the cardinals, the butcher, the man who flies an airplane and drops a bomb - they all say, `God is with me. The man who makes money, exploits others, the man who accumulates wealth and builds temples or churches, says that God is his companion. All such people believe in God; and surely, their belief is merely a form of self-expansion, it is their own conceit. Such people, those who believe in organized dogmas, who have conditioned their minds according to a particular pattern called religion, obviously can never know the ultimate reality.
