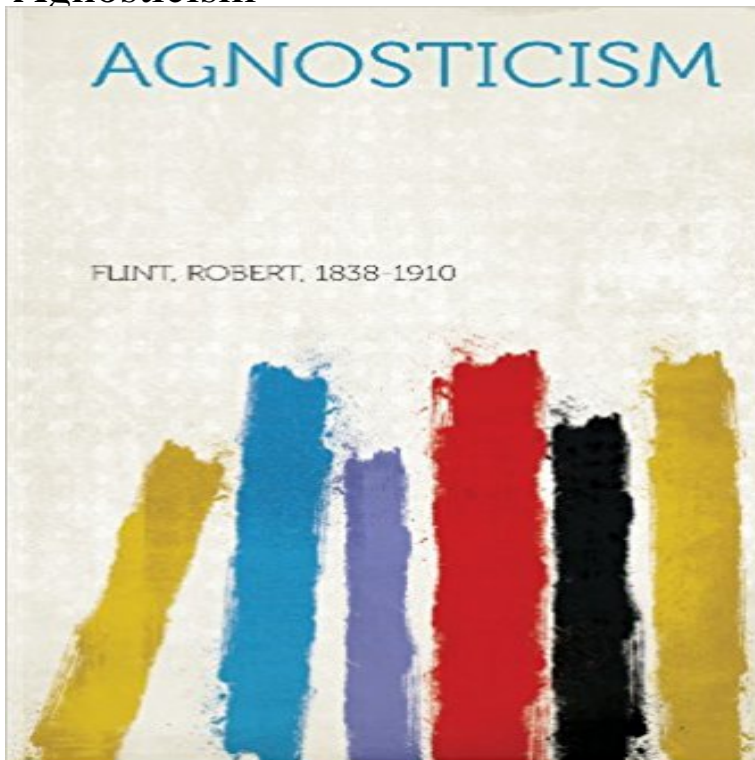


Agnosticism
