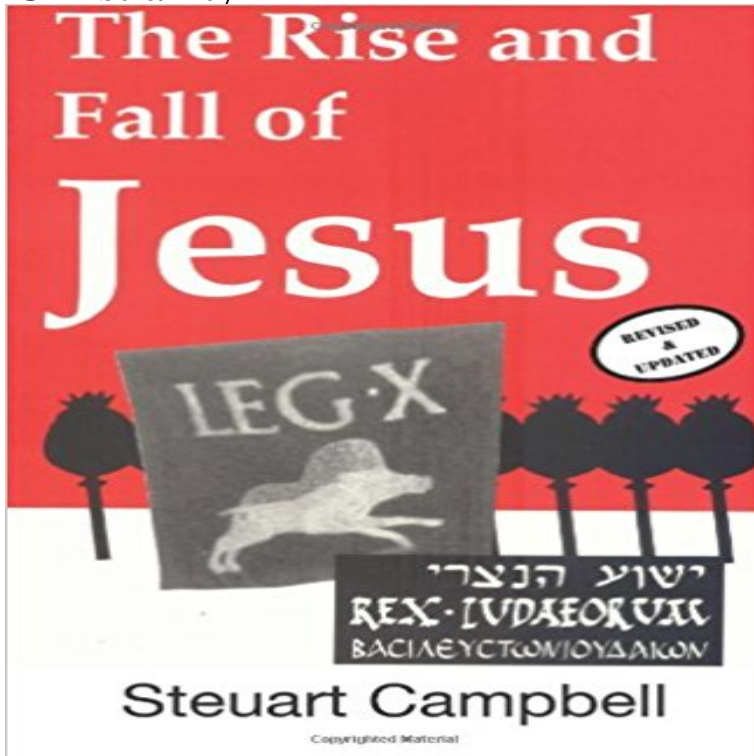


The Rise and Fall of Jesus: The ultimate explanation for the origin of Christianity
