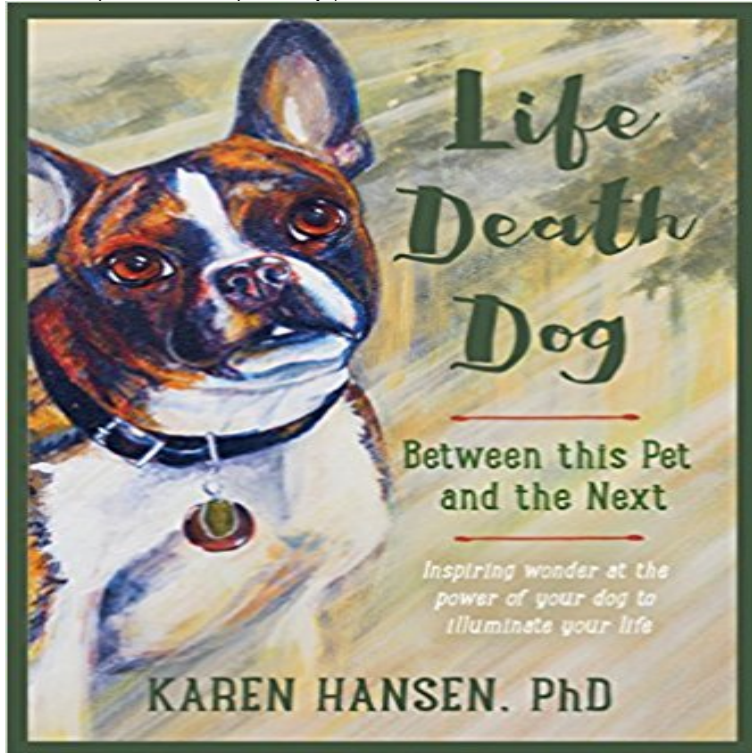


Life, Death, Dog: Between This Pet and the Next
