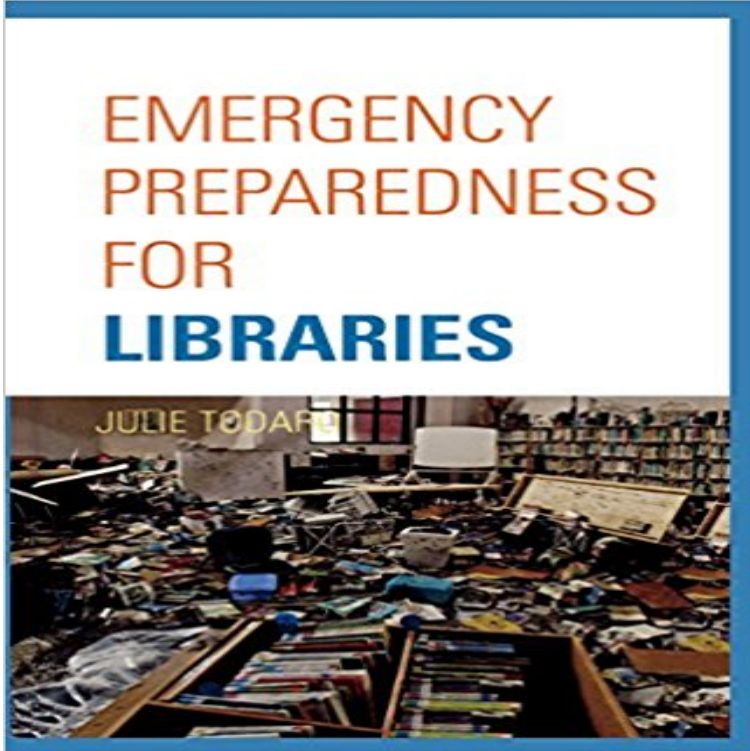


# Emergency Preparedness for Libraries
