Talking on an aviation radio and understanding air traffic control instructions can be one of the most intimidating aspects of flight training. The communication requirements for entering, departing, and transiting each class of airspace is explained in detail by following along with the author on simulated flights. A full-color sectional excerpt, in an attached fold-out format, is provided for the example flights so readers can review the map while reading the explanation for flying and talking in each area. Readers will learn everything they need to communicate effectively in VFR, IFR, and emergency conditions.
