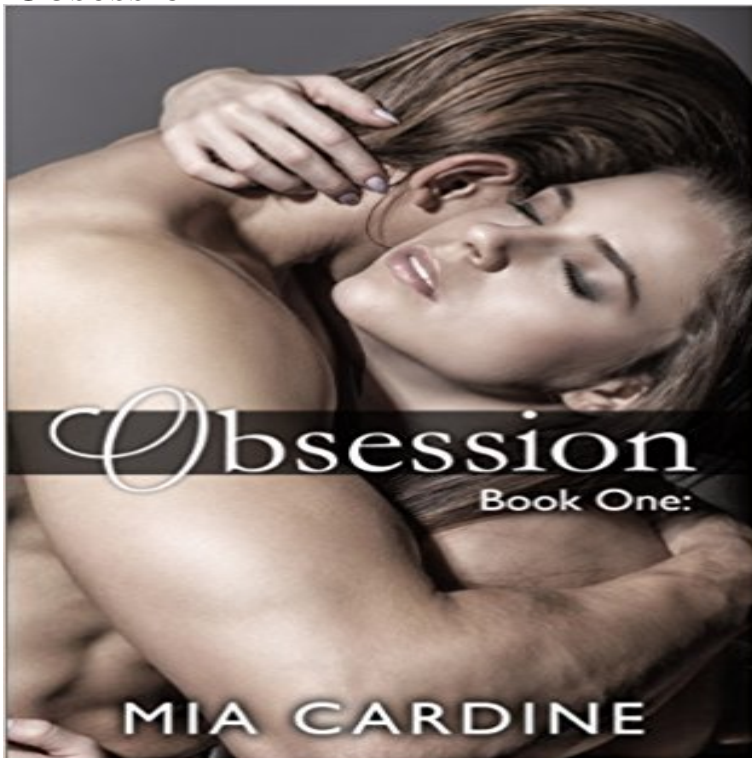


Obsession
