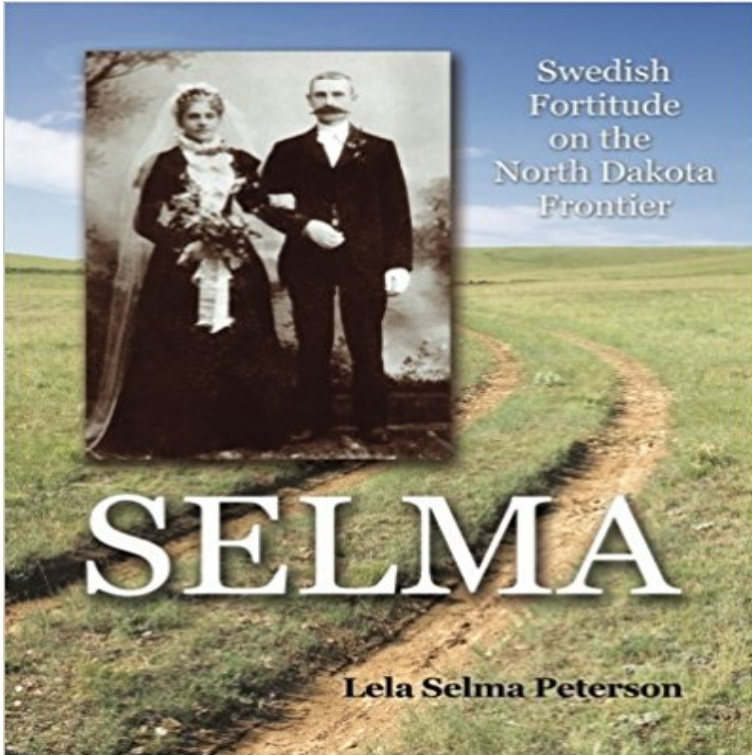


Selma: Swedish Fortitude on the North Dakota Frontier
