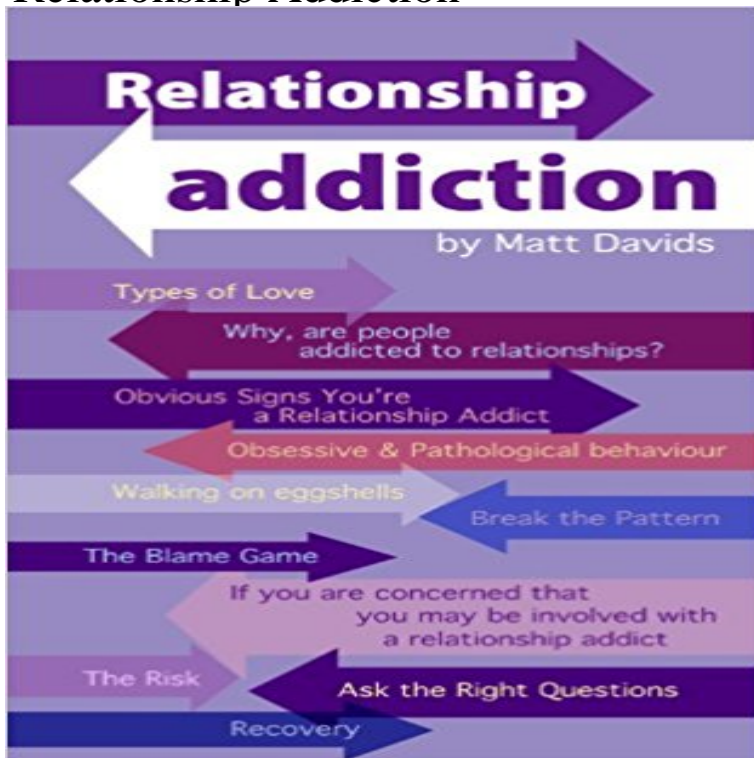


Relationship Addiction



What is relationship addiction? Any addiction is a compulsive need. When you have relationship addiction, you have a compulsive need to be in a relationship whether it is good or bad for you. You may even go as far as to do anything to be in a relationship and you may lose your sense of what is moral because of your desperate desire. Our childhood experiences do influence how we react to relationships. Many relationship addicts felt a need for love from their own parents. Fortunately if you recognise where the need is coming from you can help yourself to learn new patterns and enter healthy relationships. Sadly, many relationship addicts end up in abusive relationships, because they will put up with absolutely anything simply to be in a relationship. As with any addiction, the first step to recovery is to recognise that you have a problem. The next step is to analyse why you have the problem. It is also important to look at the effect this addiction is having on you and the people close to you. Relationships may start out normal and healthy. The change can be so gradual that the addict does not realise that the once normal healthy relationship has become a compulsion. Compulsive relationships can be extremely dangerous not only to your personal safety but if you have dependants, they could be in danger as well. The relationship addict basically seeks validation from each relationship; they do not see any value in themselves and think they need a partner to love them to prove that they are valuable. If you are not a relationship addict but suspect the person you are involved with is possibly a relationship addict you need to recognise the signs and that you may be putting yourself into danger.
